





Do You Know?



St. Clairsville Public Library

- SCPL is a School District Library which serves residents living within the St. Clairsville - Richland City School District. The service area population is approximately 16,084 people.
- The Library is open to the public 52 hours per week.
- Between 2019 and 2023, the number of Adult registered borrowers increased 58.71%.
- In 2023, Library attendance included 55,796 visits.
- In 2023, the Library offered 350 programs with 9,666 people in attendance.
- The Library's print, video, audio, downloadable, E-book and computer software collections include 751,597 items. Additional items are available through inter-library loans from other libraries.
- Between 2019 and 2023, the circulation of physical / downloadable items increased 14%.

PUBLIC LIBRARY —

- Between 2019 and 2023, electronic content use increased 255%.
- Between 2019 and 2023, total collection use increased by 22%.




It is important for the Library to continue to be a place of welcome, a source of information, and a gathering place for the community.


Current Floor Plans












Phase 1 Renovation Floor Plans








